## APPOINTMENT OF FOREIGN SERVICE VISITOR

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Don Jamieson, is pleased to announce that, within the framework of the Department of External Affairs' Foreign Service Visitors' Programme, Mr. Arthur Andrew has been appointed Foreign Service Visitor to the University of King's College, Halifax, Nova Scotia.

Mr. Andrew, a former Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs, was born in Pictou, Nova Scotia on November 20, 1915. He received his B.A. (1937) and his M.A. (1947) from Dalhousie University and a D.C.L. (honoris causa) from the University of King's College in 1971. He has served abroad in the Federal Republic of Germany, Austria, and Czechoslovakia. In 1962, he was appointed Ambassador to Israel, serving concurrently as High Commissioner to Cyprus. Later he served as Ambassador to Sweden and is currently Ambassador in Greece.
