OFFICIAL VISIT TO CANADA OF MR. MICHEL JOBERT,
FRENCH MINISTER OF STATE AND MINISTER FOR FOREIGN TRADE,
MARCH 30-APRIL 3, 1982

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Mark MacGuigan, announces the official visit to Canada from March 30 to April 3, of Mr. Michel Jobert, French Minister of State and Minister for Foreign Trade. Mr. Jobert's co-hosts during this visit, which takes place on the occasion of the meeting of the France-Canada Economic Commission, will be the Honourable Herb Gray, Minister of Regional Industrial Expansion and the Honourable Pierre De Bané, Minister of State (External Relations). During this visit, the purpose of which is to enhance trade and industrial co-operation between France and Canada, Mr. Jobert will have official meetings with the Premiers and other ministers of Alberta and Ontario, as well as contacts with business representatives. His official visit to Québec, on April 2 and 3, will include meetings with Premier René Lévesque and Mr. Bernard Landry, Minister of State for Economic Development.
