Budget, 2139. Social legislation of government implementing part of Liberal platform of 1919; obstruction by opposition of government legislation; condition of trade in 1930; dumping from depreciated currency countries at time Liberal party went out of office; beneficial effect of trade agreements completed by present government, 2139; Liberal bargaining with Progressive group in 1926; increase in exports of agricultural products under empire trade agreements; amendments to Bank Act providing for penalty for interest charges in excess of seven per cent on loans and withdrawal of privilege of circulating bank bills; taking over of gold from chartered banks at \$20.67 an ounce, 2140; increase in corporation and income taxes; pensions for the blind and for burnt-out ex-service men; pre-cooling facilities for fruit-growers in West Kootenay district; British Columbia gold mining activity; largest metallurgical works in the world situated at Trail, B.C.; labour conditions in
