Mr. Neill, seconded by Mr. Bourassa, by leave of the House, introduced a Bill, No. 8, An Act to amend the Armistice Day Act, which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The House resumed the adjourned Debate on the proposed motion of Mr. Cormier, for an Address to His Excellency the Administrator, in answer to His Speech at the opening of the Session, and the proposed motion of Mr. Mackenzie King in amendment thereto.

And the Debate continuing, the said Debate was, on motion of Mr. Spencer, adjourned.

The House then adjourned at 5.55 o'elock, p.m., until to-morrow, at 3 o'elock, p.m.
