 (i) banking, insurance, trust and loan companies, credit societies, caisses populaires and small loans companies;

(ii) customs and excise;

(iii) taxation legislation;

(iv) patents and royalties;

(v) corporate affairs;

(vi) bankruptcy.

Social Affairs, Science and Technology (m) The Senate Committee on Social Affairs, Science and Technology, composed of twelve members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, to which shall be referred, if there is an order of the Senate to that effect, bills, messages, petitions, inquiries, papers and other matters relating to social affairs, science, and technology generally, including:

(i) veterans affairs;

(ii) Indian and Inuit affairs;

(iii) cultural affairs and the arts;

(iv) social and labour matters;

(v) health and welfare;

(vi) pensions;

(vii) housing;

(viii) fitness and amateur sports;

(ix) employment and immigration;

(x) consumer affairs;

(xi) youth affairs.
