

Minutes of a meeting of the Faculty of Law
held in the office of the Dean on Tuesday, November
11th, 1930 at 5.15 p.m.

There were present:-

The Principal, the Dean, Professors
MacDougall, Surveyer, Howard,
Wainwright, LeMesurier, Tyndale and
Scott.

The reading of the minutes of the previous
meeting was dispensed with.

The Faculty approved the admission into second
year of Mr. A.E.Moll, a graduate in economics of the
University of Milan, who had completed three years
in the law course of that university.

The meeting then considered the proposed amend-
ments to the Bar Act submitted by the General Council
of the Bar, and the Dean reported the result of the
interview between the special committee of this Faculty
and a special committee of the General Council which
had met to discuss the matter. After considerable de-
bate the following resolution was moved by Professor
Tyndale and seconded by Professor Surveyer:

WHEREAS the General Council of the Bar of the
Province of Quebec has asked the opinion of
this Faculty as to the desirability of amending
the Bar Act so as 1) to require a university de-
gree as a prerequisite to admission to study law;
2) to increase the normal indenture period from
four to five years; 3) to increase the indenture
period of students attending offices and a univ-
ersity law course concurrently from three to four
years; 4) to defer the taking of the examination
