## BY-LAWS.

#### ELECTION OF MEMBERS.

The Honorary Secretary shall have printed forms supplied to members desiring to propose any candidate for membership, and the name shall be submitted at the first meeting of the Executive Committee and Ballotted for, and a two-thirds vote favoring admission shall constitute such candidate eligible, and upon the subscription being paid, applicable to the Class—i.e. Resident, Non-resident or Privileged—the candidate shall be entitled to all the privileges of the Club.

### MEETINGS.

Meetings of the Club shall be regularly held the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month at the hour of 4.30 p.m., in the general meeting room of the Club, at which it will be in order to have the Public Questions of the day freely discussed, and the policy and scope of the Club reviewed.

#### ANNUAL MEETINGS.

The Annual Meeting shall be held as provided in Article 10 of the Constitution, notice of which shall be given by the Hon. Secretary in one English and one French Conservative newspaper of the City for at least eight clear days, previous to date of meeting, such notices of meeting appearing three times in each paper.

The President shall preside at such meeting or in his absence one of the Vice-Presidents.
