Neat Cattle form a very important part of every Farmer's live stock. In selecting them, two things are very material: First, the health and soundness of the stock from which they are purchased; and Secondly, the quality of the soil on the produce of which it is intended to feed them. Stock for the dairy or the butcher should be selected from a breed of which you know or can ascertain every particular relative to their general health and soundness, and the manner in which they have been reared, including their food, shelter, &c. Always purchase Cattle that have been fed on lands of a poorer quality than your own; but
