

## CONSTITUTION.

### ARTICLE XVI.

The W D M shall assist the W M in the performance of his duties.

### ARTICLE XVII.

The W S shall attend the inside gate.

### ARTICLE XVIII.

The W Jr S shall attend the outside gate.

### ARTICLE XIX.

The W C of each term shall act as the P W C of the succeeding term.

### ARTICLE XX., PROPOSITIONS.

All propositions for membership must be in writing, stating age, name, residence, occupation and references ; the subject shall then be referred to a Committee of three for investigation, who shall report at the next regular meeting ; the candidate may then be ballotted for with ball ballots, and if not more than two black balls appear against him, he shall be declared duly elected. If rejected shall not again be proposed in any Lodge under six months.

### ARTICLE XXI.

Any brother applying for membership by deposit of card, shall pay half the initiation fee, and be subject to the same ballot as a new applicant.

### ARTICLE XXII., FEES AND DUES.

The initiation fee shall not be less than two shillings and six pence.

### ARTICLE XXIII.

The regular dues of each member shall not be less than one shilling and six pence per quarter.

### ARTICLE XXIV.

On the death of a brother, or his wife, each brother shall pay one shilling to the Lodge.
