On bill a pour objet d'autoriser la Compagnie du
Chemin de fer Canadien du Pacifique à construire et
mettre en service un embranchement dans la province

de ses pouvoirs à la Commission des transports du Ca-
nada n'autorise que la construction d'un embranchement
dans la province de la Saskatchewan, afin de desservir
une mine de papier qui est située dans la paroisse de

The purpose of this Bill is to authorize Canadian
Pacific Railway Company to construct and operate a
branch of railway in the province of Saskatchewan
from the Meadow Lake subdivision in the vicinity of
Meadow Lake to the vicinity of Dore Lake, to serve
a pulp and paper plant to be constructed by Al-
berta Forest Industries Ltd. at a certain place.

Parliamentary authority is necessary because the
powers of the Canadian Transport Commission to
authorize construction of branch lines under the Rail-
way Act are limited to those not exceeding twenty
miles in length.

1. The purpose of this Bill is to authorize Canadian
Pacific Railway Company to construct and operate a
branch of railway in the province of Saskatchewan
from the Meadow Lake subdivision in the vicinity of
Meadow Lake to the vicinity of Dore Lake, to serve
a pulp and paper plant to be constructed by Al-
berta Forest Industries Ltd. at a certain place.

2. It is enacted that the line of railway
to be constructed under this Bill shall be a
single track line, and shall be constructed and
operated in accordance with the provisions of the
Railway Act, and the regulations made thereunder,
and the provisions of the Act and the regulations
shall apply to the line and to the railway thereon
as if it were a line of railway and a railway
operated under the Act and the regulations.
