There had previously been several small social organizations in the Regiment. During the winter of 1912 and 1913, A. Company Association, the pioneers of the movement, and B. Among several successful and well attended functions held by them, were a Whist Drive and a Bohemian Concert. The desirability of an association open to all members of the Regiment was announced and the immediate formation of same, undertaken early in December.

This Association has secured the Convention Hall, Industrial Bureau for one evening each week during the months of January, February, and March, and a series of concerts, lectures and other social events will be arranged starting with a "Smoker" on Wednesday, January 14th to which every member of the Grenadiers is invited.
