rer at the succeeding meeting. They shall also visit the sick at the desire of the President and report to him. In case of the death of any member, they shall, if their services are accepted, give their personal attendance and aid to essect his decent burial. They shall also keep the scars, &c. belonging to the Society.

Admission ART. 12. The admission money shall be deposited with the Treasurer at the time the person wishing to become a Member is proposed to be balloted for. If the person is rejected, the Treasurer shall resund it.

Monthly ART. 13. Members residing out of the Province shall only pay two shillings and fix pence per month; but those who remove without giving notice thereof to the Treasurer, will continue to be charged three shillings.

Arrears. ART. 14. If any Member should be three months in arrears, at the meeting in March, the Treasurer shall report him to the Socie-
