

be the duty of the 1st Principal to have the same Insured, in the name of the Stadacona Chapter of Royal Arch Masons, No. 13, City of Quebec; and also the duty of the S. E. to keep an inventory of the same, and have it recorded in the Minute Book.

XIX.

No additions, alterations, or amendments shall be made to these By-laws, except at a Regular Convocation of this Chapter; of which alteration three months' notice shall be previously given in writing, and be subject to two-thirds majority of votes of the members present.

XX.

Rules of Order.

1. A Companion, speaking on any subject, shall rise, and respectfully address the Council, or R. W. Master.
2. No Companion shall speak twice to the same subject, unless in explanation, or as the mover of a resolution; in reply.
3. No question shall be entertained unless it be put in writing, and seconded.
4. All questions, unless otherwise determined by Masonic Law, shall be determined by a majority of votes.
