FREE GOLD IN THE SHAFT AT ELDOURADO PROPERTY

Working in Excellent Quartz at 25 Feet—Whitney Coming to the Front

Highly promising developments have occurred at the Eldorado property in southeastern Whitney, of late, a new discovery having been made in the main shaft, which was started on the 14th of last month.

"Free gold was struck in the new main shaft at ten feet in passing thru the iron cap. It occurred in a quartz stringer, and gave excellent indications of good values at depth. The gold was fine and sprinkled freely thru the stringer."

Mr. Thornley expects that in addition to the present showing of gold, the prospecting claim will be picked up in the near future. The discovery on the iron quartz was made 200 feet to the west of the main shaft.

WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Land Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made by any agency on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader. ed-tf
