New York, April 23.—The market developed an easier tone this morning, partly as a result of lower cables than expected, but also caused by favorable weather conditions reported over Sunday, and a rather free movement of the crop reported in expectation for tomorrow at Galveston and Houston.

The trading took the form of liquidation of the option, but the principal pressure was on the summer months, and a view of expected notice day. May contracts on Friday night, support to that point, but present conditions are not so favorable.

The trading in the next crop months is largely influenced by weather conditions, and recent reports from the south indicate improvement in this respect.

Of course, there is a price at which this cotton will finally move into consumption, but at present spinners prefer to pay a premium in order to secure better grades.
