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THREE MONTHS HAVE COST GERMANY EASILY HALF HER EFFECTIVES; ALLIES FASTER

Analysis of Great Campaign Shows Only Colossal Failure For Enemy—Terrible Fighting Still To Come, But August Will See Scales Turned.

NEW YORK, June 23.—The first thing to be said of the operations on the west front in the week of June 11-13 is that the record is the most hopeful single circumstance since the German offensive began, on March 21. The latest phase of the "Battle for Paris" practically ended after three days in a bloody check for the armies of the crown prince—a check recalling the Verdun episode and recalling the more vividly because of successful French counter-attacks.

Recognizing that the enemy still holds half of his strategic reserve, anywhere from fifty to seventy divisions intact, and that he has gained some valuable ground in his latest attack and still possesses the power to deliver another blow comparable with those in Flanders and on the Aisne, we have still the right to a measure of optimism based upon recent events.

Colossal Failure. In all his larger purposes, then, the German offensive was a colossal failure. His appropriation of "cannon fodder," the casualties he was willing to incur to attain his object, was exhausted before the fifth day, and on that day he had definitely abandoned his attack, leaving his hands empty.

That on the Aisne, on May 27, in some of the most terrible and desperate fighting of the war, the German army, after a week of all-out effort, and finally, that of June 9, between Noyon and Montdidier, which culminated in the capture of the town, failed to achieve the objectives sought.

Now at the end of three months, with a loss of about 500,000 men, the German has drawn more than 2,000,000 men to the front, and has captured in prisoners and in booty, recaptured about 2,000 guns, and has lost more than 2,000 guns.

It is a desert as a result of German devastations. He has won signal battle successes, but he has defeated only one army, the fifth British army, in such fashion as to impair its organization, and in the case of the French he has put no more than four divisions, those which held the Aisne positions, out of the line.
