Cannot Hold Office Under Crown or Vote.

BARRED FROM PARLIAMENT

> OTTAWA, May 8 .- Hon. Arthur Meighen presented in the House of Con ons this afternoon his bill to di nchise defaulters under the M. S. e classes covered by the bill consed all those who failed in the bligations under the act. They are dis-ualified in the following respects for period of fifteen years: 1. From holding office under the From being a member of Parliament, or a member of the Senate.3. From voting in any Dominion elec-

The bill provides that any defaulters who have satisfied any conviction law-ully obtained and the punishment imosed shall not be included. Nor ar-hose included who came in under the mnesty proclamation of August last or any who, having been apprehended or any who, having been apprehended, ctually served in the military forces. Further, any who subsequently satisfied the terms of any legal conviction hereby become relieved of the disqualidation provided by the act.
