**SUNDAY LIFT LIFTED IN**  
CONN AFTER 215 YEARS  
Connecticut has become skittish in  
these days of change and war.  
The state has lifted its Sunday lift  
for the first time in 215 years, and the  
thing was done under sober, deliberate  
action of the legislature which makes it  
legal henceforth forever.  
There were no rumblings heard from  
the underground, but it is assumed the  
bones of many a righteous Puritan must  
have turned in their grave at what hap-  
pened here. People drank soda water,  
bought fruit, read newspapers and even  
bought cigars on Sunday. But nothing  
terrible happened. 1702 against work,  
the blue law of the state of anything on  
Sunday, except in case of mercy and  
necessity, under a penalty of a fine of  
\$50 was amended at this year's session  
of the legislature. The law has been  
liberalized and its name color softened.  
In the future such things as milk,  
bakery products, fruit, ice cream, can-  
dies, confectionery automobile supplies,  
cigars and tobacco may be sold on Sun-  
day. The law has been violated in  
many of the towns in the state, the local  
authorities winking at transgressions.  
The Gross bill and fruit stores have  
been closed on Sunday for about twelve  
years.  
The general assembly concluded it  
was better to legalize acts which could  
not be prevented. The legislators re-  
cognized public sentiment was not in  
sympathy with the rigid blue law en-  
acted in 1702. In 1913 the first suc-  
cessful effort was made to modify the  
Sunday law when the measure known as  
the Gross bill was passed. It permit-  
ted recreation on Sunday afternoons.
