FRANCE UPBUILDS ONE RUINED AREA


\$1,800,000,000 Spent on the Nord Region in Three Years-Families 500 Fewer; 100,000 Men Lost-Of 53,107 Homes 2,948 Have Been So Far Restored.

Paris, Sept... 25—The results achieved by reconstruction work which has been going on for three years in the single Department of the Nord (one of the ten devastated) have now been published in detail down to July 1, 1922. From the beginning the French government made itself responsible to the inhabitants of these devastated regions for all war damages, and in default of reparations to be paid by ourmany, the French government has so far borne the expenses of reconstruction. The figures indicate the answer to the curious question which has lately been asked in America. What is being done with the 36,000,000,000 francs in paper money notes of the Bank of France which are in circulation?

From the armistice to July 1, 1922, the government has paid out in this one department 15,595,000,000 francs, or \$1,300,000,000 at the average rate of exchange. Of this large sum only a fraction was paid in kind, of which a part was accounted for by German coal and building materials and restitution of machines—all reckoned at international prices brought up to the level of British sanctions. These are the only reparations yet made by Germany, since France has so far not received from her the equivalent of one cent in cash on this score.

Railways Half Repaired.

In public works, which are essential to agriculture and industry alike, the destruction of 550 miles of main railway lines has been repaired and of 825 miles of side railways destroyed 250 miles have been repaired and the remainder are under way. Of the 2,464 schools existing before the war, 2,337 have been re-opened. Of the many churches destroyed or damaged, 184 have been completely rebuilt; 199 provisionally, but forty-two are still replaced by army barracks; thirty-three hospitals have been re-established, twenty are provisionally installed, and four are still in barracks.

This is the exact summary of reconstruction in the most populous but relatively not the worst injured of the ten devastated departments of France to July 1, 1922.

The Dominion government and the provinces of Canada have joined in an extensive programme to improve and maintain the highways. The Canada Highways Act of 1919 was a recognition of the importance of good roads and elicited the co-operation of all sections of the Dominion. The bill made been expended.
