FAMOUS WORKS OF MICHELANGELO ARE SHOWN IN CASTS

Exhibition of Statuary of Italian Master Opens in New York, in Metropolitan Museum.

Michelangelo's most famous works shown in casts, are placed on exhibition in the big special room of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York, on the upper floor, the southeast gallery, and it is an exhibition which will attract wide attention. It is in the nature of an anniversary exhibition, although it is not called that, for the February 18, just passed, was the anniversary of the death in 1564 of the great Italian, and March 28 is the anniversary of his birth, which took place in 1475. The exhibition will be continued for six weeks, and will include the birth date.

Travelers knowing Italy will be delighted with the setting of the statuary. On the north and south walls are the figures of the famous Medici tombs, those of Giuliano and Lorenzo, the "Day" and "Night," placed to suggest the exact setting as they are shown in the new sacristy of the Church of San Lorenzo at Florence. On one side of the tomb on the north wall is the beautiful "Pieta" of St. Peter's, Rome, and on the other the "Madonna and Child," a later work of the artist, of the Church of San Lorenzo. Hung on the wall, in medallion form, above the beautiful Madonna and dead Christ of St. Peter's are crossed keys of St. Peter, and the arms of Florence, the fleur-de-lis, are above the Madonna of Florence.

On either side of the Medici tomb on the south wall are two beautiful temples of the work of Michelangelo now at the Louvre in Paris, different of stone, from the Church of San Pietro in Vincelli, Rome; there is a "Bacchus

and Faun," of the Bargello, Florence, and a reproduction of the head of the colossal statue of David at Florence, with a candelabra from San Lorenzo.

Balancing the Moses at the west end of the room is the great "Pieta" or "Deposition," which stands back of the pulpit in the Cathedral in Florence and which can be much better seen in the reproduction on exhibition. There is a relief, "Madonna and Child," from the Church of Notre Dame, Bruges; another relief of the "Battle of the Centaurs" and the Lepitha, and a fine "Bargello Bust," conceptions of the "Bound Captive," and in the centre of the room are smaller

figures, "Crouching Youth," which was one does not know where it may be now—at the Hermitage, St. Petersburg, and "Cupid Kneeling," of the South Kensington Museum, England.

Standing against the east wall is Michelangelo's magnificent statue of "Moses," the law giver, with the tablets Balancing the coat-of-arms of Florence and Rome high on the south wall are medallions, one giving the dates of the birth and death of the artist and the other telling that he was at once "Sculptor, Painter, Architect and Poet."

It is a great opportunity to see so many important works of the master

among sculptors together and not less interesting to know that the casts have been for some time in the possession of the Museum, lost to view in the room of casts, with the work of other artists, or stored away. To enter the gallery is like stepping into Italy, with the Medici tombs and the great figure of the Moses first catching the eye, and there is also the privilege of seeing at the same time the works of the artist from galleries and churches or other countries. The idea is a suggestion of the assistant director of the Museum, Joseph Breck. Pedestals of a soft gray green have been arranged for the greater number of the pieces, bringing the statuary into an agreeable relief.
