"Angel of Siberia" Is Fourth Woman To Win \$40,000 Nobel Prize



New York, Feb. 13.—If Miss Elsie Brandstrom, the "Angel of Siberia," receives the Nobel peace prize, she will be the fourth woman to win the Nobel literature prize in 1923. With her prize money she bought back her beloved ancestral home, Marbach, for which she has been one of the great benefactors of her life.

Madame Curie, discoverer of radium, and her husband was awarded the Nobel physics prize in 1903, and Madame Curie received the Nobel chemistry prize in 1911, becoming thereby the first woman to receive a Nobel prize and the only one to whom it was given twice.

Baroness Von Suttner, first woman to receive the Nobel peace prize, was awarded it in 1905.

The third woman was Selma Lagerlof, a Swedish novelist, who received the Nobel literature prize in 1909. With her prize money she bought back her ancestral home, Marbach, for which she has been one of the great benefactors of her life.

The prize money in each case amounts to approximately \$40,000, and constitutes the annual income from the \$9,000,000 estate left by Alfred Nobel, inventor of dynamite.
