"If we would spend less time on the problem of divorce, and more on the problem of marriage, the world would be better off.


NEW PENNA. LABOR LAWS CURTAIL WOMEN'S WORK


Philadelphia, Nov. 19—The enforcement of the new law regulating the employment of women in Pennsylvania may result in hundreds of women losing their places in Philadelphia hotels. The main feature of the law is that no woman can work more than fifty-four hours a week or more than ten hours a day; nor can they work more than six days in any one week. According to Mahlon W. Newton, president of the Philadelphia Hotel Association, the number of women thrown out of work will be at least 500 and may be much greater. The hotel managers, he said, are willing to retain the women but because of the necessity of hiring extra help where women are employed wages will be reduced. In consequence, he said, some of the women, unable to live comfortably on less money, will enter other occupations. Men and boys will take the places of the women.

SAYS WOMEN ARE CEASING TO WEAR FEATHERS

Washington, Nov. 19—Women are abandoning the feathers of birds on headgear, as decorations, according to Dr. Joseph Acklen of Nashville, Tenn., who is here to assume his duties as chief warlen of the United States to enforce the recently enacted migratory bird protection law. Colonel Acklen, who is to serve without pay, expects to visit every section of the state, enlisting game wardens and the various sportumen's organizations in the work. The change in feminine fashion and the gradual abandonment of furs and feathers in the decoration, of women's hats, the colonel believes, however, is the most hopeful sign he has seen in his work thus far.






