

NATIONAL SOCIAL SERVICE CONGRESS

Important Body to Meet in Ottawa early in March - Distinguished Speakers to Attend.

The first Canadian National Social Service Congress is to be held in Ottawa on March 3, 4 and 5th. It is being held under the auspices of the Social Service Council of Canada and the National Committee for the Suppression of the White Slave Traffic. In these two federations the following Canadian bodies are officially represented:

- The Church of England, the Methodist Church, the Presbyterian Church, the Baptist Church, the Congregation of the Roman Catholic Church, the Trades and Labor Congress of Canada, the Dominion Grange and Farmers' Association, the Salvation Army, the Canadian Purty-Education Association, the Evangelical Association of North America, the National Council of Women.

It is expected that delegates will attend the congress from all church courts, labor organizations, farmers' granges, local and national councils of women, Women's Christian Temperance Unions, Young Women's Christian Associations, local churches, local temperance societies, provincial and other bodies in sympathy with any or all of the reforms to be considered at the congress.

STREET RAILWAY TO EXTEND TO LITTLE RIVER AND COLDBROOK

Permission Given by County Council Yesterday Afternoon, after Four Hours Discussion - Councillor Agar and Warden in Lively Tilt - Fix Dates for Completion of Different Sections.

After four hours discussion yesterday afternoon the County Council decided to grant the street railway permission to extend its lines to Little River and Coldbrook, and fixed the date for the completion of different sections. The session was only adjourned by some half-hearted tilt between Com. Agar and the warden. The council has to submit a bill to the legislature, relieving the company of the obligation of removing snow and ice and taking care of the road bed for a payment of \$400 per mile.

The committee which has been negotiating with the St. John Street Railway for an extension of the tracks from Kane's Corner to Mt. Pleasant avenue by Aug. 1st, 1914, and operate the same. Pleasant avenue to Little River as soon as a proper bridge is built over the brook to the northeast of the Municipal House, and the third section from Little River to Lee's brook on the Old Loch Lomond as soon as a suitable bridge is built over Little River.
