In accordance with the instructions received through you from the Indian Department on April 13th., last, we proceeded with the construction of the irrigation pumping plant for the Kamloops Industrial School. We have superintended the erection of the plant and the construction of the flumes and ditches necessary to get the water on the land. The whole system is now completed and has been in successful operation for several days.
