SYNOD OF HAMILTON AND LONDON.

BUXTON FUND.

The Clerk read the report of the Committee on the Buxton Fund, showing that the sum of \$231.23 had been received during the year and paid over to Mr. King. On motiou of Dr. Cochrane, duly seconded, the report was received and adopted, thanks tendered to the convener and the committee, and the committee re-appointed for the following year. The committee is as follows: Dr. J. R. Battisby, convener, and Messrs. A. McColl and W. Walker, ministers; and Messrs. J. A. Taylor and R. Urquhart, elders.

DIVISION OF MISSION FIELD IN THE BRUCE PRESBYTERY.

There were read deliverances from the Presbyteries of Bruce and Maitland, anent dividing the mission field of the Presbytery of Bruce—the Maitland Presbytery renewing their application for a division of the mission field, and the Bruce Presbytery opposing it. Dr. Laing was heard in support of the overture. After discussion, on the motion of Dr. Laing seconded by Mr. R. Hamiltou, the overture was received and adopted, and Dr. Thompson and Mr. Turnbull were appointed to support it before the General Assembly.
