

members without ballot, entrance fee or monthly subscription.

XX.

Any ordinary member may introduce, without any ballot or payment, any stranger for any number of days, not less than a day at a time and not exceeding fourteen in the year, if resident more than five miles from New Westminster. The Committee shall have the power of admitting by ballot, as a temporary member, any person not residing within five miles of New Westminster, who has been duly proposed and seconded by two ordinary members of the Club and whose name shall have been placed on the black-board for at least three days previous to his election as a temporary member for a period of one month, and not exceeding three months, at the rate of \$5 per month, payable in advance.

A register of the number of days for which a visitor is introduced shall be kept by the Secretary of the Club, and the introduced member shall be forthwith notified accordingly.

Every honorary, privileged, introduced or temporary member shall be entitled during his respective membership to all the privileges and advantages of the Club, except voting, holding office or introducing members.

Any ordinary member who shall be for one calendar month in arrear of any payment whatever due to the Club, may be posted as
