S. of Edward Maher and Catherine Whelan, who emigrated to St. John from Carlow, Ireland, in early part of present century. B. in St. John, 23 Sept., 1830. Ed. there. M. Mary, dau. of Mr. Jas. Green, of St. John. An architect and builder. Is an Alderman of St. John, and Presdt of the St. Patrick's Society of that city. First returned to Parlt. for present seat at last g.e. A Conservative.—*St. John.*

MONTGOMERY, WILLIAM. [*Restigouche.*]

S. of the late Hon. W. Montgomery, who represented Restigouche in present House many years. A merchant. Has sat for present seat since 1867. Elected by acclamation at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Dalhousie.*
