An Act to smend the an incorporating The Lake St. Louis and Province Line Railway Company.

HEREAS the persons named in the Preamble. Act hereinastermentioned have truly represented that ov their Petition to the Legisture, that by she Public Notices which they gave 5 of their intention to apply to the Legislature for the said Act and by the Bill as originally brought before the Legislative Assembly, the limits within which the Railway mentioned in the said Act was to be constructed, were 10 those hereinafter appointed,—but that by an amendment introduced at so late a period of the Session that they had not time duly to consider its effect, the said limits were so nerrowed as to render it probable that the 15 said Railway cannot be made to join any Railway in the United States, so as to connect the City of Montreal with the great Cities on the Atlantic, without which the public utility of the said Railway must be 20 very greatly diminished, and the possibility of constructing it with advantage to the Seekholders must be very doubtful:—Be it therefore enacted. &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of Limits assign-25 the same, That for and notwithstanding any ed for the Railway unthing in the first-section or in any other part der 10 & 11 of the Act passed in the Session held in the Vict. c. 120, tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled "An Act to incorporate 30 "the Lake St. Louis and Province Line Rail-"way Company", the Company incorporated under the said Act may make and complete the Railway in the said Act mentioned, from the Village of Sault St. Louis in the County 40 of Huntingdon, to any place at or near the
