The operation, at 6630 Turner Valley Road, opened in December, 1978 in its two-storey, 21, 000 square-foot office and warehouse. Since then, the number of employees has increased from 75 to 110

Dick says donations at peak periods pour in at the rate of 1,500-2,000 per day. World Vision films and edits its own television programs at its Mississauga offices to help raise funds. Its latest project is an attempt to raise \$250,000 for emergency relief supplies in El Salvador.

The timing of the building expansion has not yet been decided. The committee of adjustment gave permission for the expansion although the construction will leave the company with six parking spaces less than required by the municipal bylaw
