

The following is a true copy of a Minute of a Meeting of the Committee of the Privy Council, approved by his Excellency the Governor General on the 10 TH JUNE 1924

The Committee of the Frivy Council have had before them a report, dated 10th June, 1984, from the Right Honourable the Secretary of State for External Affairs, representing that the Convention concluded between Canada and the United States at Mashington on the End March, 1985, to secure the preservation of the Halibut Fishery of the Northern Pacific Ocean, has now been approved by the United States Senate without reservation.

The Committee, therefore, on the recommendation of the Right Honourable the Secretary of State for External Affairs, advice that Your Excellency may be pleased to address a telegraphic despatch to the Right Honourable the Secretary of State for the Colonies asking that His Majesty be humbly moved to ratify the said Convention, and that the instrument of ratification be forwarded to Your Excellency to be exchanged in Washington by the representative of the Canadian Government against the similar ratification of the President of the United States.
