SECRET.

Government have asked for confidential and friendly counsel of H.M. Government as to whether they should lay the whole incident on the Jugo Slav frontier before the Council of the League of Nations, and ask for a Commission to study the question and propose measures designed to prevent recurrence of these incidents.

H.M.Government have replied that this must necessarily be question for decision by the Bulgarian Government itself and that they cannot advise. It the same time, however, H.M.Government are letting the Bulgarian Government know that they would not be surprised if such appeal was made but that since they would, when the matter came before the Council, be called upon to investigate and pronounce judgment upon the merits of the appeal, it is, of course, impossible for them to express any opinion on the matter in advance.
