

vouchers, available to the Dominion for audit or examination upon request and to furnish information in relation thereto.

11. Statements of accounts for expenditures made by the Province pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement, shall be submitted by the Province to the Dominion Commissioner of Unemployment Relief, accompanied by a certificate of the Provincial Auditor that expenditures have been duly made in accordance with such statements and have been or within one year from the date thereof will be audited by him; and such statements and certificates shall be in the form prescribed by the Dominion Commissioner of Unemployment Relief.

12. The Province further agrees that in connection with any application made for financial assistance from the Dominion by way of a loan, advance or guarantee in relation to this Agreement as provided for in section 4 of the Unemployment Relief and Assistance Act, 1936, or under any amendment thereto, it will furnish under appropriate headings, and in such detail as may be satisfactory to the Minister of Finance, such information as he may deem necessary in the premises.

13. The Dominion and the Province each agree to use its best endeavours to obtain from all regular transportation concerns operating in the Province the most favourable rates possible for the transportation of workers referred to in paragraph 1 of this Agreement.

14. It is agreed that the Dominion Commissioner of Unemployment Relief may at any time direct an examination in connection with any measures executed or being executed pursuant to this Agreement and that the Province will facilitate, as fully as it can, every such investigation.
