

2. Article XV, Canada-U.S. Trade Agreement:

Agreement does not come into operation until it is
ratified by His Majesty (i.e. after its acceptance by Parliament.

Certain Sections (Articles I, III, IV) "shall be applied" in a provisional way pending ratification on and after January 31, 1936.

Parliament will have opportunity for fullest investigation of every item of Agreement before it is approved and ratified.

Same method as with Budget:

Changes made when Budget is brought down, pending approval by Parliament.
