My attention has been drawn to your failure to reply to letters of November 9th and November 12th, 1917, as well as March 19th, 1918, the first and last mentioned having reference to repairs to the barn on the Jackson property, and the third to collection of rental from Mr. Jackson for the year 1916-17.

It was at your own request that on November 9th, last, you were authorized to make purchases of lumber and other material which might be delivered when the roads were in good condition, and the Department must insist on knowing what was done in the matter.

It is hardly necessary for me to state that the rental must be paid and that forthwith.

If I do not receive replies from you regarding these two matters next week, I shall have to take into consideration the placing of the affairs of this agency
