Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant, regarding an orphan girl, Christina Tom, whom you state that you have made arrangements to place in the St. Mary's Mission Boarding School.

In reply I beg to say that the Department will approve of her admission as a supernumerary grant earning pupil, but, it must be distinctly understood that she is to replace the first vacancy that occurs among the regular grant earning pupils.

You will be good enough to arrange to have her sent to this school as soon as possible and you should forward an application and certificate of health for her to the Department.
