His Majesty having been graciously pleased
to declare & enjoin, by ~~His Royal~~ proclamation
given at His Court at St James's
the 7th day of Oct^r 1763, that the trade
with the Indians shall be free & open to all
His subjects whatever; in obedience thereto
this licence is given to ^{Monsieur Fleury} M^r ———, of this
city of ~~Montreal~~, to pass unmolested,
with the canoes & merchandize specified in the margin, to
Michilimachinac, & from thence to such
markets, or parts, as he shall find most
advantageous for the disposal of said mer-
chandize; provided always that such places
are not prohibited by His Majesty's regu-
lations, nor by those of His ^{Superintendent and Council} Commis-
saries appointed to direct the indian trade; He
