



Paddy Moran, the Quebec goal tend, is a native-born Quebec hockey player, and has been recognized as the best goal-tend playing the game. He is about 33 years of age, and is a graduate of the old Quebec Crescents, intermediate champions in the early nineties. Paddy played on the Quebec team in 1904 when they won the senior championship. He also played with Haileybury and All-Montreal, some three seasons ago. But for a few seasons away from home he has played with Quebec since breaking into senior hockey. He is a star goal custodian in lacrosse as well as hockey.
