

Privileged or Transient Members (necessarily Conservatives) are entitled to the privileges of the Club for a period not to *exceed two weeks*, without entrance fee or subscription, but shall have no right to introduce any friend, or to in any way interfere with the management of the Club ; such Privileged or Transient Members must be introduced by a Member of one of the other four classes of Members, and the name of both the person introduced and the Member shall always appear in the Visitors' Book upon the day of introduction, specifying day and date and duration of privilege, always subject to the Board of Directors.

Members elected in any other month than January shall pay the proportionate amount of their subscription.

14.—Supernumerary Members.

Any ordinary Member who shall remove his residence to a greater distance than ten miles from Toronto (all his subscriptions then due being paid) may give notice in writing to the Secretary of such removal, and of his intention not to make use of the Club thenceforward ; and such ordinary Member shall cease to be liable to pay the yearly subscription so long as he shall continue to reside at such distance from Toronto, and does not use the Club, shall be considered a Supernumerary Member, and his name
