CAP. XXI.

An Act to continue the Act for the further increase of the Revenue, by imposing a Duty upon Articles imported from Foreign Countries.

[Passed the 11th day of January, 1831.]

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Act, passed in the tenth year of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, entitled, An Act for the further increase of the Revenue, by imposing a Duty upon Articles imported from Foreign Countries, and every matter, clause and thing, in the said Act contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued from the thirty-first day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-one, until the thirty-first day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-two, and no longer.

CAP. XXII.

An Act to continue the Acts for granting a Drawback of the Duties on Brown or Raw Sugar, used in the Manufacture of Refined Sugars within the Province, and for regulating the mode of obtaining the same.

[Passed the 11th day of January 1831.]

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act, made and passed in the Fifty-seventh Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, entitled, An Act for granting a Drawback of the Duties on Brown or Raw Sugar, used in the Manufacture of Refined Sugars within the Province, and for regulating the mode of obtaining the same; and also the Act, passed in the seventh year of His said late Majesty's Reign, to revive, amend and continue, the said Act, and every matter, clause and thing, in the said Acts contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued from the thirty-first day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-one, until the thirty-first day of March, which will be in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-two, and no longer.
