The General Assembly having been, by Proclamation, prorogued to this day, the Legislative Council met:

Mr. President acquainted the House that His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor had provisionally appointed the Honorable Edward Palmer, by Warrant, bearing date the Thirty-first day of January, 1860, a Member of this House, who desires to be admitted.

Ordered, That Mr. Forgan and Mr. Johnson be a Committee to attend Mr. Palmer, and see him qualified.

Mr. Forgan from the Committee appointed to attend Mr. Palmer, and see him qualified-reported, that they had, according to order, attended Mr. Palmer, who took the oaths in the presence of the Lieutenant Governor.

The Hon. Mr. Palmer was then introduced between Mr. Forgan and Mr. Johnson, and took his seat.
