

At the GENERAL-ASSEMBLY of the Province of *Nova-Scotia*, begun and holden at HALIFAX, on the Sixth Day of *June*, Anno Domini 1770, in the Tenth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, of *Great-Britain, France, and Ireland*, King, Defender of the Faith, &c. and there continued by several Prorogations until the Sixth Day of *October*, Anno Domini 1774, in the Fourteenth Year of His said Majesty's Reign, being the Fifth GENERAL-ASSEMBLY convened in the said Province.

An Act in further Addition to, and Amendment of, and for continuing the several Acts of the *General-Assembly* of this Province therein mentioned, relating to the Duties of Impost and Excise on Wines, Beer, Rum and other distilled Spirituous Liquors.

E it Enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, That from and after the First Day of *January*, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Five, there shall be paid by the Importers of all Rum and other distilled Spirituous Liquors, that shall be imported or brought into this Province (except the Produce or Manufacture of *Great-Britain*, legally & directly imported from thence) an additional Duty of Five Pence per Gallon over and above the Duty already imposed by "The Act made in the Eighth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act to amend, render more effectual, and reduce into one Act the several Laws made by the *General-Assembly* of this Province, relating to the Duties of Impost on Beer, Rum, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors."

After the First of *Jan. 1775*, an additional Impost of Five Pence per Gallon on Rum and Spirits.

II. *And*
