On the 20th, Sherman having nearly completed the investment of the city, and captured Fort Lee and many of the minor outposts, the rebel agents to command effectually every position held by the forces under the command of General Hardee, sent a summons by flag of truce to the effect that if the place was not in a certain time surrendered, a bombardment and assault would at once commence.

The following is extracted from the leading article of the Richmond Enquirer of December 16: "Whenever we are reduced so low that we cannot maintain the contest then we can secure liberty and nationality by the sacrifice of slavery.
