## DID BORDEN KNUCKLE TO BOURASSA IN APPOINTMENT?

Blondin, New Minister, Pronouncedly Anti-British in His Utterances—May Be Reward for Helping Pass Closure Bill.

OTTAWA, Oct. 20.—The action of Sir Robert Borden in taking Mr. P. E. Blondin into his cabinet created great surprise in Ottawa, and has given rise to great dissatisfaction among Conservatives.

Mr. Blondin has been a fiery Nationalist ever since Henri Bourassa broke away from Sir Wilfrid Laurier, and launched his anti-British campaign. Mr. Blondin's utterances even outran those of his leader, Mr. Bourassa, in the Drummond-Arthurs election. Mr. Blondin took the office in the west Chateaugay by-election, held but a little more than a year ago.

It was expected that E. L. Patin, of Montreal, or Albert Seigney, M. P. for Dorchester, or Mr. Marchal, of Montreal, might be taken into the cabinet in place of Hon. Bruno Nantel, but the elevation of Mr. Blondin was never dreamed of. This afternoon Mr. Blondin took the office in the west Chateaugay by-election, held but a little more than a year ago.

Already hundreds of wreaths and bouquets have been banked at the base of the Nelson monument in Trafalgar square, where great crowds were present throughout the day.

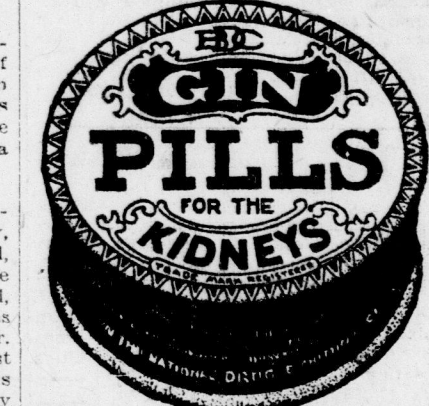

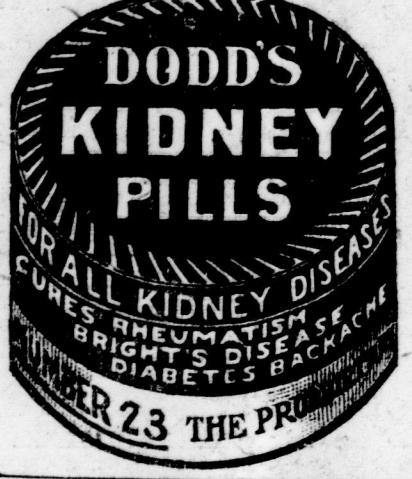

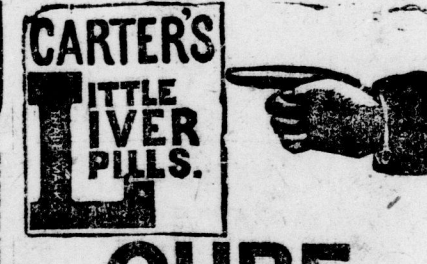
