Bible Students Is Bearing Fruit.

"Japan and the Earthquake" was the subject of Rev. Bruce Hunter's sermon for the morning service at First Methodist Church yesterday. He based his remarks on Ellijah's speech from the book of Kings, where the prophet spoke of experiencing first an earthquake, then a wind, lastly a fire, and after these things, a still, small voice.

In introducing his subject, Mr. Hunter reviewed the great disasters of history, and stated that in every case, although the disaster had been accompained by a lamentable loss of life and property, it had always been the precursor to greater and better things. As in the life of the individual, so in the life of nations, trials and tribulations always tended toward a higher standard of excellence, both in the reconstruction of the ruined property and also in the better and bigger outlook of the citizens of the afflicted country. That the people of Japan are able to face their calamity squarely, and reconstruct a finer Japan from the ashes of the old, he has not the slightest doubt.

Another side of the question which Rev. Hunter stressed when he made an appeal for funds for the relief of Japan, was the question as to why this affliction had been visited on that country. For years, he stated, the western nations have looked with the gravest suspicion and distrust on the actions and aims of the Japanese. The war was supposed to have drawn all nations nearer together into a closer bond of union. In the case of Japan and Canada and the United States the reverse seems to have been the case, and in his own mind, Mr. Hunter is convinced that one of the reasons for the recent upheaval in Japan was the needed opportunity for Canada and the States to show that they were big enough and human eniough to cast aside all the past foolish talk about "yellow peril" and the aspirations of Japan, and to replace this mallicious meanness with a spirit of generous giving which would enable Japan to recover more quickly from the devastation which fell on Nippon.


