The seate is sit for Harbour and reliefe; wpon the way betweene ws and Virginia, and consequently of advantage to win any action that may engage ws, either by way of offence or attempt, in regard of those parts of the World. The Seas are sorich, as they are able to advance a great Trade of sishing; which with Gods blessing, will become very serviceable to the Navie; and the increase of sishing there, cannot despaire of sinding Portes enem to went the commoditie at prositable rates.

Now if you would understand what motives were have as home with as to carry us thither; doe but looke upon the populous nesses our Countrey, to what a surfet of multitude it is subject; consider how charitable for those that goe, and how much enseit will be for those that stay, to put forth some of our numbers, to such an imployment of living. Compare the English nature with others; and sinde whether were have not as much courage as they, both to undertake and maintaine; onely we lose it, in having lesse industry. Turne then towards the Lowe Countries, behold how they have wonne upon us, by saking advantage of our sitting still; (and most remarkeable in this point of sishing) which, if their Audit were published, would be found (I believe) one of the best Agents they have, both for their strength and wealth.

There is another motive also, which among stown Ancestors was wont to finde good respect, namely, the honour of the action, by the enlarging of Dominions; and that which will crowns the worke, will be the advancement of the honour of God, its
