R Hydrarg. chlor. corros. gr. vj.
Sodii chlorid. gr. xxxvj.
Aq. destillat. f 3 x.

M. Sig.: Inject daily from five to eight drops hypodermically.—*Hebra*.

R Pil. hydrargyri gr. xx.
Ferri sulph. exsiccata .. gr. x.
Ex. opii gr. v.

Ft. pil. No. xx. Sig.: One pill three times a day.—*Otis*.

R Potass. iodid. 3 ij.
Ammonii carbonatis... 3 ss.
Tr. cinch. comp. f 3 iv.
Syr. aurant. cort. f 3 iss.
Glycerinæ f 3 j.

M. Sig.: A teaspoonful, well diluted, after each meal.—*Keyes*.

R Tr. myrrh. f 3 ss.
Potass. chlorat. 3 iij.
Aquæ q. s. ad f 3 vj.

M. Sig.: Wash mouth every two or three hours. (For mucous patches.)

R Hydrarg. chlor. mit.,
Lycopodii. aa 3 ij.

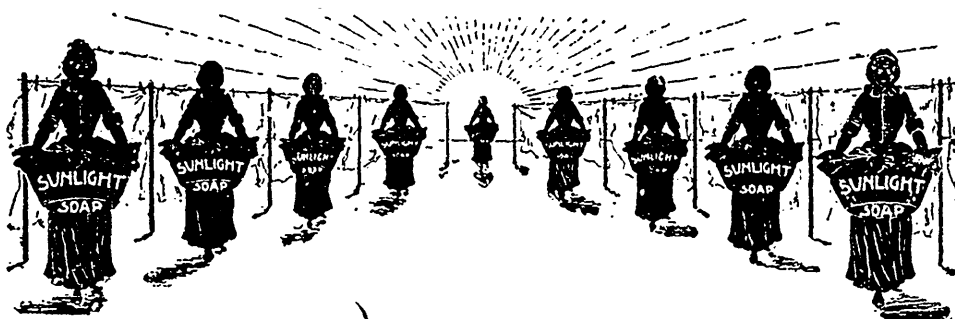
M. Sig.: Use as snuff three times daily, in syphilitic lesions of nose.—*Gross*.

R Hydrarg. chlor. mit. gr. xij.
Ol. vaselini M ccxxv.

M. Sig.: Give twenty to thirty minims hypodermically.—*Balzer*.

R Hydrarg. chlor. corros. gr. j.
Potass. iodidi. 3 ij.
Tr. gentian comp. f 3 iij.

M. Sig.: A teaspoonful three times a day.—*Charity Hospital, N. Y.*
