

3. The Parties shall take reasonable precautions to ensure that any information created in the implementation of the Agreement or this Protocol that they consider to be confidential, is clearly identified as confidential, in accordance with the respective law or policies of the Parties.
4. A Party receiving or possessing information identified as confidential in accordance with paragraph 2 or 3 shall take reasonable precautions to ensure that:
 - (a) the information is used exclusively in accordance with the Agreement or this Protocol and not for any other purpose;
 - (b) the information is not disclosed or transferred to any other person without the prior written consent of the Party that supplied or created the information; and
 - (c) any person in that Party's jurisdiction receiving or possessing the information, and any other person to whom that information is disclosed or transferred pursuant to subparagraph (b), limit access to that information only to those individuals who must have access to such information.
5. A Party is deemed to have taken "reasonable precautions" if that Party takes all precautions available to it to:
 - (a) protect confidential information in its possession and control; or
 - (b) require persons under its jurisdiction to protect confidential information in their possession and control.
6. This Protocol does not require the Parties to transfer any information if that transfer is prohibited by the respective law and policies of that Party or by their international obligations.

ARTICLE 13

Cessation of Co-operation

1. A Party shall have the right to suspend or cease further co-operation under the Agreement or this Protocol, and to suspend or terminate the Agreement or this Protocol, in whole or in part, if the other Party:
 - (a) terminates or materially violates a safeguard agreement with the IAEA which means, for Canada the 1972 Canada-IAEA Safeguards Agreement and the 1998 Canada-IAEA Protocol and for Romania the 1973 EURATOM-IAEA Safeguards Agreement and the 1998 EURATOM-IAEA Protocol;
