MR. MARTIN'S VISIT TO EUROPE

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Paul Martin, will be making a trip to Europe May 2-13. He will visit Cyprus May 4-5 to see the Canadian Contingent of the UN Force and call on President Makarios and Vice President Kuchuk and the Special Representative of the UN Secretary-General. He will open the Canadian Consulate General in Marseilles May 6. In Paris on May 7 and 8 he will meet with the French Foreign Minister and also with Heads of Canadian missions in Western Europe. In London Mr. Martin will have talks with the British Foreign Secretary and the Secretary of State for Commonwealth Relations. He will then represent Canada at the NATO Ministerial Meeting from May 11-13.
