MEETING BETWEEN THE RIGHT HONOURABLE JOE CLARK  
AND SIR GEOFFREY HOWE  
LONDON, JUNE 20

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Rt. Honourable Joe Clark, announced today that he will hold informal conversations over dinner in London Friday June 20, 1986 with Sir Geoffrey Howe, the British Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary. The two ministers will discuss a number of issues including the recent report on South Africa of the Commonwealth Eminent Persons Group and prospects for the Commonwealth Summit meeting in London in August.

Mr. Clark will have met in Dublin in the afternoon of June 20 with the Irish Prime Minister, Mr. Garret FitzGerald, and he will have a working dinner in Cork on June 21 with the Irish Foreign Minister, Peter Barry. He will also meet with Indian Foreign Minister, Shiv Shankar, in Cork on June 22, and participate in the June 23 dedication ceremony of the memorial to the victims of the Air India Flight 182 tragedy. The monument is located on the shore of Dunmanus Bay in Southwest Ireland.
