Case No. 12—October 31, 1964—1 victim

The killing took place in Trois-Pistoles, Quebec, and the victim was a corporal in the Q.P.P. The victim was killed when he went to the accused's home accompanied by a constable to serve a social welfare court summons. An argument took place and the corporal died as a result of being hit by 12-gauge shot-gun pellets. Accused was 48 years of age. He was declared unfit to stand trial and committed to St. Jean-de-Dieu Hospital, Montreal.

Case No. 13—December 17, 1964—1 victim

The killing took place in Whitbourne, Newfoundland, and the victim was a police constable. Accused had escaped from H.M. Penitentiary, St. John's, Newfoundland, with 3 other prisoners. Together the 4 escapees stole a car and drove to Whitbourne. They were located by the victim and another constable and while being arrested the 4 of them attacked the other constable, seized his revolver, and the accused then shot the victim. Accused was 18 years of age. He was convicted of capital murder and his sentence was commuted to life imprisonment.

Case No. 14—April 10, 1965—1 victim

The killing took place in Kelowna, British Columbia, and the victim was a constable in the R.C.M.P. A report was received that the accused was holding a girl in his cabin against her wishes. The victim and another constable were sent to the scene. The victim was shot while approaching cabin. Accused escaped while the other constable sought help. Accused later committed suicide after being cornered by R.C.M. Police. Accused was 59 years of age.

Case No. 15—October 14, 1965—1 victim

The killing took place in Sudbury, Ontario, and the victim was a police sergeant. The accused, on probationary leave from a North Bay mental hospital, shot the victim through an apartment door where he and a fellow policeman went to pick up the accused and return him to the mental hospital. The accused committed suicide after shooting the victim. Accused was 44 years of age.

Case No. 16—April 4, 1966—1 victim

The killing took place in Ottawa, Ontario, and the victim was a constable in the O.P.P. The victim was in the process of having the accused admitted to the Royal Ottawa Sanitorium, when the accused suddenly darted out of the building. In an effort to apprehend him, victim lost his gun and it was retrieved by accused who fired several shots at the victim. Accused then fled from the scene and was subsequently apprehended. He was committed to the Ontario Hospital for the mentally insane at Penetanguishene, Ontario. Accused was 25 years of age.
